Considering the current pandemic situation and travelling restrictions in our region, these courses will be implemented through online delivery. On the other hand, since the MTESOL program has residential phases, the SEAMEO-RELC have anticipated the resumption of face-to-face classroom teaching in Singapore by 2022, depending on the COVID-19 situation then. However, if international travel is still not possible, this course will continue to be conducted online and the course duration will be updated at a later time.

For our selection purposes, aside from the entry and admission requirements of SEAMEO RELC, we encourage each region to nominate one (1) language teacher per course with the following qualifications and corresponding documentary requirements:
