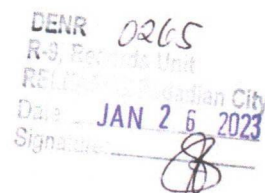
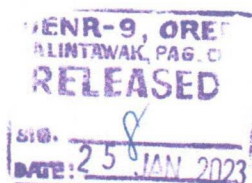

Poster Making Contest
World Wetlands Day 2023

Kabasalan National High School | February 2, 2023 | 8:00 AM

THEME : *Wetland Restoration.*

Wetlands are vital for human survival due to range of ecosystem services they provide, from supplying food and resources such as rice, fish and freshwater. To date, wetlands are facing major problems and threats. Thus our theme for this year highlights the urgent need to prioritize wetland restoration and the steps we need to take to revive and restore degraded wetlands.

MECHANICS , CRITERIA AND OTHER DETAILS

1. The Poster Making Competition is exclusively for high school students who attended the IEC campaign conducted by DENR 9. One (1) participant per school and no registration fee will be collected.
2. Registration starts at 8:00 in the morning while awarding starts at 1:00 in the afternoon. The student's school ID must be presented upon registration.
3. The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the theme, "Wetland Restoration".
4. The following materials will be used in the contest :
 - a. A 1/8 illustration Board
 - b. Pencils and coloring materials (oil pastel, crayons and markers)
 - Materials to be provided by DENR 9.
5. Participants will be given 2 hours to complete their posters. Entries must be done simultaneously with other completion participants during the specified period.
6. Entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

7. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable
8. Winners will receive the following:
 - a. 1st Place - P3,000 + token
 - b. 2nd Place - P2,000 + token
 - c. 3rd Place - P1,000 + token
9. All entries will automatically become the property of DENR IX and will be used as design on marketing and collateral materials.
