**2023 RAPID THRU SIKAP DE SIBUGAY
BEST IMPLEMENTING SCHOOLS**

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

This Division

1. The Schools Division of Zamboanga Sibugay through the Curriculum and Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct the search for RAPID Thru SIKAP de Sibugay Best Implementing Schools 2023 (*please see attached schedule of judging per level*).
2. The search conforms to the thrust espoused by DM 013, series 2023 on the National Learning Recovery Program (NLRP) which laid-down the National Reading Program (NRP), the National Mathematics Program (NMP) and other reading activities which are deemed to improve reading and mathematics skills of learners.
3. The objectives of the annual search are as follows:
 - a. Seek to address the occurrence of frustration and non-readers in school,
 - b. Account for schools with properly documented implementation without non-readers; and;
 - c. Recognize schools and teachers with exemplary performance.
4. District level selection shall be spearheaded by their respective PSDS/DIC; while the Division level shall be headed by the CID with select division personnel.
5. Travel and other expenses of the Division Level judges relative to the final round is chargeable to division MOOE or other available funds subject to the usual government auditing rules and procedures.
6. Private schools may benchmark from previous winning schools or nearby schools to start their reading program and to be able to fully participate in the succeeding years.

A. General Guidelines

1. All elementary and secondary schools are qualified to join, so long as they implement continuously SIKAP Thru RAPID-de-Sibugay reading program.
2. Previous winners in the I-READ and Zeal for Progress in Reading are still eligible to join as long as they have not won consecutively for three (3) years.
3. School reading profile must reflect the authentic data validated by the PSDS/DIC.
4. To validate reading progress of learners, listing is per learner reflecting their improvement per reading level per grading period. Purely numerical presentation is discouraged. Numerical reporting is on summary or comparative of data only.
5. All district level-selected schools (first placer only) shall prepare a 3-4 minute video showcasing their best school practice on reading, accompanied by verifiable data. This shall be submitted starting Nov. 25-30, 2023.
6. For this competition, the **elementary** is composed of **central schools** and **non-central schools**. Each will have three (3) district winners but only the first placers shall proceed to the Division Level competition.
7. The **secondary** shall likewise have 2 sub categories: **Big school** and **small school** categories. Big school is hereby defined operationally as the IUs school and secondary schools with more than 50 teachers. Small school on the other hand, are those with 49 teachers and below.
8. The decision of both the district level and division level are deemed final and unappealable.

B. Criteria for Judging

A. Preliminary Round: District Level

1. No. of combined Non-readers & Frustration Level to Instructional Level- **40%**
Ex. $32/50 \times 20 \times 100 = 12.8$
2. No. of Frustration Level Learners to Independent Level- **25%**
Ex. $10/23 \times 25 \times 100 = 10.87$
3. Coziness/Child-friendliness of the IREAD Center- **15%**
Includes:
 - Arrangement of books, GIYA sa Pagbasa, shelves, Tablets, IREAD Materials, ERK Materials, etc-----5%
 - Cleanliness and presence of Trash bins -----5%
