



- 3. The celebration of the 2025 Philippine Veterans' Week and the 83rd commemoration of the Araw ng Kagitingan will be on April 5 to 11, 2025, respectively.

NATIONAL POSTER MAKING CONTEST

1. Background and Objectives

In celebration of the 83rd Araw ng Kagitingan and Philippine Veterans Week, the Department of Education (DepEd), and the Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP) are sponsoring a National Poster-Making Contest.

These contest aim to showcase the historical sites across the country from the Second World War II era, where significant landmarks and memorials now stand. This initiative seeks to cultivate a sense of pride and reverence among Filipinos for the sacrifices made by our veterans, serving as a poignant reminder of the valuable legacy that has granted us the freedom we cherish today.

2. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 11 & 12, learners enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. Private school should be duly recognized by DepEd. Previous winners of all DepEd-Special Events Unit-organized contests are ineligible to join to give others a chance.

3. Scope/Theme

The entries should depict the life, works, and heroism of our Filipino heroes who fought for our country and should be in line with this year's theme, "KABAYANIHAN NG BETERANO: SANDIGAN NG KAUNLARAN AT KASAGANAAN NG BAGONG PILIPINAS

4. Entry Specification

Only submitted entries that satisfy the requirements and specifications of the contest will be considered official.

- 4.1 The poster should be on a 15"x 20" illustration board.
- 42 Contestants may use any medium of his/her choice, (e.g. oil paste, crayon, and watercolor)
- 43 The poster must be described in one or two sentences. The description must be typewritten and printed on a 1/2 A4 bond paper and posted at the back of the entry together with the following information:
 - 4.3.1 Name of Learner
 - 4.3.2 Contact Number
 - 4.3.3 School
 - 4.3.4 Division
 - 4.3.5 Region
- The Philippine Flag should not be used as the background of the poster. If used as part, it should be placed in a conspicuous place to show its importance to the artwork (please refer to Sec. 39 -Prohibited Acts under Republic Act (RA) No. 8491 titled "An Act

83RD ARAW NG KAGITINGAN AND PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK **CONTEST MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES**

NATIONAL ORATORICAL CONTEST

Subject to such changes as may be determined appropriate, the following general rules shall apply:

1. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 learners enrolled in any public and private elementary schools nationwide. Private school should be duly recognized by DepEd. Previous winners of all DepEd Special Events Unitorganized contests are ineligible to join to give others a chance.

2. Theme and Content

The oratorical piece must be in Filipino, original, never been published, and expounding on the theme: "KABAYANIHAN NG BETERANO: SANDIGAN NG KAUNLARAN AT KASAGANAAN NG BAGONG PILIPINAS".

The piece must be delivered for a minimum of five (5) minutes and a maximum of seven (7) minutes.

The oration MUST NOT, in whole or in part, whether express or unplied, offend any race or religious freedom, nor should it be against the environmental laws, honor, dignity, or the moral standards of Filipinos.

3.2. Delivery	40%
Posture, gesture, eye contact, facial expressio	
pronunciation, volume and mastery	
3.3. Persuasion and Stage Presence	10%
