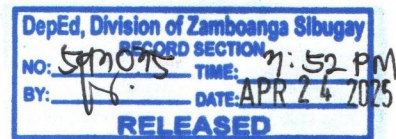

**CONDUCT OF GRADE 3 SUMMER PHONE-BASED MATH TUTORING
THROUGH mEDUCATION PROGRAM**

1. In response to the results of the recently conducted Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA) for End of School Year (EoSY) 2024–2025, which revealed that 31.46% or 4,588 Grade 3 learners out of 14,854 are performing at the emerging and developing levels, this division offers a Phone-Based Math Intervention Program that shall be implemented this summer 2025, other than the Bawat Bata Makababasa Program (BBMP). This initiative, is through mEducation, and made possible in partnership with Innovations for Poverty Action (IPA), a non-profit organization dedicated to evidence-based solutions for improving learning outcomes.
2. To ensure the smooth and effective implementation of the Phone-Based Math Tutoring program, the following guidelines shall be observed:
 - a. Schools with grade three learners who are in emerging and developing are expected to implement Phone-Based Tutoring
 - b. The conduct of Math Phone Tutoring is voluntary in nature
 - c. Grade 3 adviser/s of the identified schools is/are required to provide the teacher-implementer the list of learners with contact number or FB messenger account of their parents to be used during the 4-week implementation.

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- d. Each learner is required to submit a parent's consent prior to the implementation of the program. (see attached template)
 - e. If there are no grade three teachers who are willing to serve, school head may recommend other teachers
 - f. Identified teachers shall be trained online by the mEducation
 - g. Two Hundred Pesos (Ph200) load allowance shall be provided per teacher thru the schools MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules
 - h. AIP of the concerned schools shall be enhanced reflecting the load allowance of teachers
 - i. There should be at least 8 learners per teacher-implementer.
 - j. Only 40 minutes online/phone call session per learner per week. This shall be done for four weeks only
 - k. mEducation shall provide the schedule in such a way that BBMP shall not be affected
 - l. Teacher-Implementers shall be granted service credits following the set guidelines per DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024 and Deped Order No. 010, s. 2025, six hours actual service is considered one day service credit.
 - m. The computation on the number of hours spent in Phone-Based Tutoring will be determined by mEducation, which shall be the basis in granting the number of days service credits.
3. Tentative timeline:
- April 28-30, 2025: Training of Teachers and Baseline
 - May 05-30, 2025: 4-week (40 minutes per week per student)
 - June 02-06: Endline Assessment
4. Attached are the list of implementing schools and mEducation teacher-implementer. Schools are identified based on the results of the RMA focusing on the number of learners that belong to emerging and developing level.



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5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is expected.
