In observance of the National Anti-Trafficking Awareness Month (NATAM), the PCPC and PCAT-VAWC will be spearheading a commemorative activity on July 30, 2025 (Wednesday) at the Capitol Site, Ipil Heights, Ipil, Zamboanga Sibugay Province.

In line with this, we would like to invite your good office to send ten (10) participants to join the event. Their participation will not only contribute to the success of the activity but will also help deepen their awareness and understanding of human trafficking issues, victim protection, and the critical roles that law enforcement professionals play in promoting social justice and safeguarding vulnerable sectors.

• One (1) DepEd personnel to assist in the distribution of bread and coffee.

One of the highlights of the celebration is a Color Fun Run, scheduled from 5:30 AM to 7:00 AM. As this is a physically active component, each participant is required to submit a signed waiver, indicating voluntary participation and confirming that they are physically fit and free from any known health risks. Participants are also advised to bring an extra shirt to change into after the run, in preparation for the succeeding portions of the program, which will feature advocacy sessions on the following topics:

- Republic Act 11862 Expanded Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act
- Online Sexual Abuse and Exploitation of Children (OSAEC)
- Child Sexual Abuse and Exploitation Materials (CSAEM)

For logistical purposes, an attendance sheet is attached to this letter, to be accomplished in advance by confirmed participants. This list will be used as the basis for the issuance of race bibs and claim stubs for towels after the fun run.

Furthermore, we respectfully request your office to send representative to bring the completed attendance sheet and waiver forms, and to attend the final coordination and briefing meeting on July 29, 2025 at 2:00 PM at the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) for the distribution of race bibs and final reminders.
