THE ELECTRONIC ONLINE MONITORING SYSTEM (e-OMS) TEMPLATE**



1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 10. S. 2016 or the “Policy and Guidelines for the comprehensive Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene WASH in Schools (WinS) Program which established quality standards for water, sanitation, deworming, and health education. the Three Star Approach (TSA) is used by the WinS Program as an integrated system for monitoring, performance recognition and quality assurance guided by DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018.
2. This Office officially announces the opening of the National Uploading and Validation of the WASH in Schools (WinS) Program for SY 2025-2026. The uploading will commence on January 26, 2026.
3. Please be advised of the following:
 - a. Ensure that the downloaded monitoring forms are the latest version which includes the SBFP indicator requesting the number of beneficiaries disaggregated by sex and submit hard copy of your WinS Monitoring Form thru the School Nurse in the School Health and Nutrition Section of this Division. Deadline of submission shall be on February 27, 2026.
 - b. In the event of discrepancy between the result of the offline monitoring form and the uploaded monitoring at the e-OMS, the result of the uploaded report in the e-OMS shall be the official star rating, The star rating indicated on the uploaded form shall prevail.

- c. For non-DepEd elementary and secondary schools, please upload a blank form only.
4. In the event of an uploading interruption, the issue will be coordinated directly with ICTS-SID. In case the ICTS-SID advises the system maintenance is required, Division WinS Coordinators will be notified accordingly.
5. To be guided properly, All SDOs WinS Coordinators are highly encouraged to revisit DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016 and DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018.
