SUBJECT: CONDUCT OF THE CY 2026 QUARTERLY NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL

The Philippines is situated along the Pacific Ring of Fire, making it highly susceptible to frequent and destructive earthquakes and volcanic activity. This inherent geological risk necessitates the institutionalization of robust preparedness measures, a priority established following the devastating Yogyakarta, Indonesia earthquake in May 2006. This incident prompted then-President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo to direct the former NDCC to conduct a simultaneous drill, which eventually led to the quarterly conduct of the Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED).

The NSED is a cornerstone of the NDRRMC's initiatives under the leadership of the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) in partnership with the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology which aims to assess the nation's capacity to respond to earthquakes, particularly in ensuring public safety through well-organized evacuation and response procedures.


